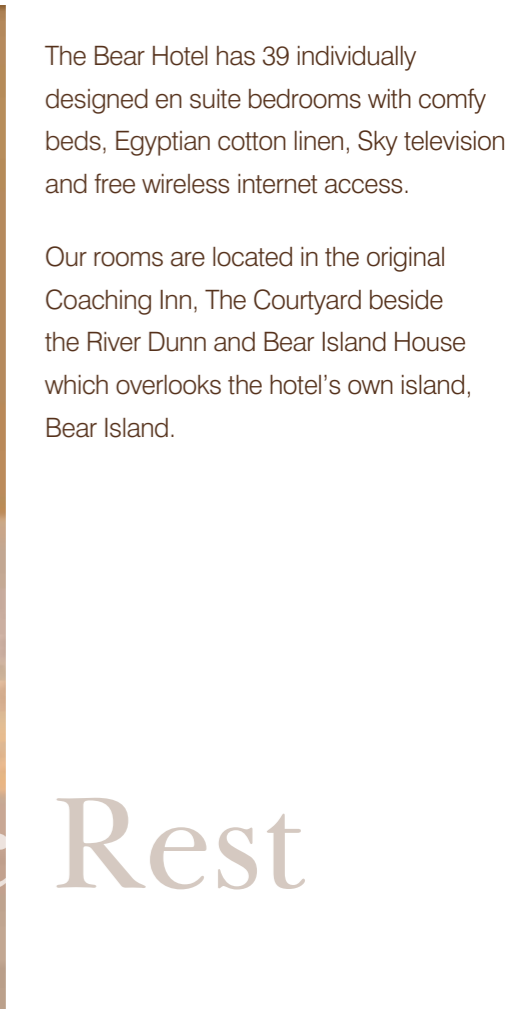




Hospitality since 1464...

The Bear is one of England's oldest Coaching Inns. We have been the focus of hospitality since 1464 and have entertained a number of royal visitors. Once owned by Henry VIII and (at different times) two of his wives, the hotel was visited by Elizabeth I, was the headquarters of Charles I before the second battle of Newbury and in 1688 was where William of Orange negotiated the Crown of England from the commissioners of James II. Today we pride ourselves on offering our guests superb food, accommodation and service in a unique location.

Located in the quintessential market town of Hungerford on the banks of the River Dunn, we are situated in the heart of the North Wessex Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, a spectacular landscape that includes tranquil open downland, ancient woodland and chalk streams. Hungerford is known for its antique shops and the famous Kennet and Avon Canal. Easily accessible, Hungerford is only 4 miles from the M4 with direct rail links to London.
